Project HIRED Wounded Warrior Workforce supports disabled veterans in their transition from military to civilian employment by:

- Offering career exploration and development services
- Facilitating retraining, job searches, and job placements
- Providing veterans with holistic support services

How can the Wounded Warrior Workforce help me?

With Project HIRED, you can discover new career options, make plans for job training, learn workplace skills, and network both before and after being hired. Our services offer you:

- *Access to our unique and unparalleled expertise in career development, training, and HR strategy* for individuals with disabilities and a deep understanding of the veterans community.
- *Partnership with you and your employers for your entire career* to build and sustain a productive working relationship.
- *Access to regular events, social media, and a portfolio of services* to connect you with other vets, employers, and local community supporters, organizations and resources.

Veterans services include:

Career Assessment and Exploration

Career assessments are generally paper/pencil or online evaluations that help veterans identify their career interests and work goals. Career exploration refers to researching and collecting information about specific careers, such as job outlook, training requirements, working conditions, and typical salaries. Used together, career assessment and career exploration helps you identify the gap between where you currently are in your career and where you want to be.

Training Services

Clients of Project HIRED receive free 24/7 access to hundreds of Internet-based courses that can be completed just about anywhere in the world. The courses are provided through a partnership with Manpower, one of the world's largest suppliers of Internet-based training.

Courses include:

- **Business:** Accounting, customer service skills, interpersonal communication, interviewing skills as well as professional development and other topics such as business ethics, sexual harassment sensitivity, and leadership.
- **Technical:** Information technology, Six Sigma, quality assurance, and the latest desktop technologies.
- **Desktop Skills:** Word, Excel, PowerPoint, Oracle software and other popular in-demand applications.

Workshops and Networking

We offer a multi-part workshop series that covers a wide range of job readiness topics such as how to sell your skills and knowledge correctly, your disabilities rights, and effective interviewing skills.

We also offer a weekly Job Club, which is a networking environment for our clients to meet each other, members of the employer community, and representatives of support organizations. At Job Club you can gain additional knowledge about jobs, employment trends, or specific companies.

Job Search and Placement

Project HIRED provides computer-based resume writing services and personalized resume assistance is available, if needed. Our career coaches can also help you with development of the job search, interviewing, and salary negotiations skills you need to obtain the job you want.
